2011 CLASSIC CANOE MARATHON WORLD SERIES

VIII EDITION – 2011

The canoe and kayak Adige Marathon on river Adige will take place on Sunday 16th October 2011.

The marathon is organized by “Terradeiforti Sport A.S.D.” in collaboration with Canoa Club Pescantina A.S.D., Canoa Club Verona A.S.D and Canoa Club Borghetto A.S.D.

Four courses are in program:

1. COMPETITIVE RACE- from Borghetto di Avio (Trento) to Pescantina (Verona) km. 35;
2. CANOE AMATEURS- from Dolcè to Pescantina km. 20;
3. RAFTING AMATEURS – from Dolcè to Pescantina km 20;

Rules 2011

1. PARTECIPATION

1. COMPETITORS

The registration for the competitive race is open to all men and women that are registered to the Italian Canoe and Kayak Federation (FICK) or, if foreigners, to the Federation of their country, only if regularly registered to ICF.

At the moment of registration, a bib number will be given to each participant. This must be handed in at the end of the race to the staff of the organization, in order to collect the race bag.

Under the bib number each participant must wear a regular life jacket, otherwise he will be considered out of race.

The helmet is also compulsory, otherwise the participant will be considered out of race.

2. AMATEURS

Men and women with any kind of human-propulsion single or multiple boat can participate. A bib jacket will be given to every participant for organization purposes at the time of paying. It must be worn and shown during all the course, otherwise the participant will be disqualified and will be unable to use the services of the organization.

Every participant must wear a regular life jacket under this bib jacket, otherwise the participant will be disqualified.

The use of the helmet is highly recommended.

3. RAFTING AMATEURS

Men and women with their own raft or with raft given by the organization can participate. In the latter case a form needs to be filled in. Each participant should wear the life jacket, otherwise the participant will be disqualified.

2. 3 JACKPOT FOR CANOE AND KAYAK COMPETITORS

The total prizes amounts to € 8.000 (eight thousand euros)
and it is reserved only for the first three positions for Senior men and women categories.

Criteria for assigning prizes:

Best time: 300 euro.

Men categories with at least 12 participants and women categories with at least 6 participants will be awarded with fixed and additional prizes as below

Fixed prizes

To the 1st classified: € 150,00

To the 2nd classified: € 100,00

To the 3rd classified: € 75,00

Additional prizes

The jackpot of € 8.000,00 (eight thousand), without the fixed prizes, will be subdivided to each category in proportion to the number of participants.

AMATEURS PRIZES

The total value of the prizes, excluded rafting, is € 6.000,00 for amateurs

The following prizes will be awarded:

One canoe to the club with the highest number of participants;

The other prizes **will be drawn** (canoes for tourism and competition, various technical objects for canoeing, other gadgets)

PRIZE DRAW: The public draw (depending on the number of participants and prizes available) will take place at the end of subscriptions.

LIST OF PRIZES: A complete and numbered list of the amateurs and a list of the winners of the prizes will be shown at the finishing line in piazza San Rocco in Pescantina at the end of the extraction, in the INFO box.

3. REGISTRATIONS

1. BEGINNING OF REGISTRATIONS

Registration will be open on 5th October 2011.

The participants need to fill the form on the site www.adigemarathon.it
Payment receipt will be requested for participation.

REGISTRATIONS PROCEDURES

From 5th October to 14th October until 24:00: registrations on internet on the site www.adigemarathon.it filling in the specific form after the payment of the participation fees. The receipt of payment must be shown at the race office.

Saturday 15th October from 14:00 to 19:00: registration for amateurs and bib numbers collection for competitors at the race office in piazza San Rocco in Pescantina.

Sunday 16th October from 8.00 to 9.30: bib numbers collection for competitors at the race office in Borghetto.

Sunday 16th October from 8:30 to 11:30: registration for amateurs at the race office Dolcè.

5 PERMISSIONS AND DECLARATIONS

The participants after the registration give these permissions and declarations:

- Permission to use personal information by the organizers, according to D.Lgs. 196/2003
- Unwritten declaration of suitability for canoeing, declining any responsibility towards the organizers.
- Permission to be shown on television, multimedia publication of their own image relating to filming that takes place during the event.

4. PARTECIPATION FEES

ITALIAN COMPETITORS, CANOE AMATEURS AND RAFTING AMATEURS

Individual fees is € 25,00 (twentyfive) if registered before 14th October at 24:00 (Competitors) for Senior and Master; € 15 for Junior and Boys.

€25,00 (twentyfive) for Amateurs registered before 15th October at 19:00 , € 28,00 (twentyeight) for registrations made on the morning of 16th October in Dolcè.

FOREIGNERS

€ 25,00 (twentyfive) to be given at the race offices.

The fees are not refundable, even in the case of cancellation of the event.

Payment can be carried out on a post office, current account number **65.79.73.18** in the name of Terradeiforti Sport with the motive "ADIGE MARATHON TERADEFORTI 2010".

YOUNGS

For the amateurs less than 16 years old the fees is 15 euro, comprehensive of race bag.

FAMILIES

For families (at least father, mother and one son) the fee is of 40 euro comprehensive of 1 race bag and meal tickets for all. For families composed by more than three people the fee is 50 euro comprehensive of two race bags.

Please note that competitors cannot register after 14th October.

7 DISTRIBUTION OF BIB NUMBERS

Bib numbers and the race bag can be collected:

On Saturday 15th October from 14.00 to 19.00 at the Marathon office in piazza San Rocco in Pescantina.

On Sunday 16th October at the Marathon offices at the various departure points where a token for collecting the race bag at the finishing line in Pescantina will be given.

N.B. : who pays by postal current account will have to show the receipt of payment, at the distribution points, otherwise the participation fee of € 28,00 has to be paid.

8 RACE BAG

Each participant will be given:

- a 4 use bag
- an author's labeled bottle of Terradeiforti wine
- a meal token for the day of the competition
- a souvenir post card
- Calendar 2012

9 STARTING POINTS

COMPETITORS: 10,15 am in Borghetto di Avio;
AMATEURS between 12.00-12.30 am in Dolcè;
RAFTING and SUP: 11am in Dolcè;

10 TIMING AND RESULTS LIST

Times of the competition will be taken by the Siwidata.com experts, that will show the results at the end of the race,.

A list of participation for the category AMATEURS will be shown.

11 SAFETY RULES

Following the FICK and ICF competition code. Life jackets , helmet and unsinkable canoes are obligatory.

12 CONTROLS AND BEHAVIOUR

The moral and sportive behavior of the competitors is subject to the unquestionable judgment of the organizers that could decide to expel the participant from the event. The Marathon is also a test of education and public spirit: the participants are invited to make a concrete contribution to cleaning up the environment.

12 SAFETY AND ASSISTANCE

The organizers decline any responsibility for accidents that may occur to participants or that may be caused by themselves to people or things during the event. The ambulance service is guaranteed until 16.00 on 17th October 2008 through all the race course.
